Re: Enhancing and Safeguarding your Online Banking Experience – NEW ONLINE BANKING SYSTEM ONLINE AS OF 2/8/21

Dear WTNB Online Banking Customer:

As you know, in addition to traditional banking services, West Texas National Bank offers a full-suite of financial solutions for its business customers, **which can be accessed within a fully digital setting all while maintaining full customer-security.**

With this letter we have great news for you! West Texas National Bank is pleased to share news of our **enhanced** secure online business banking system!

Access to this new system is secured through our dedicated **securebrowser** which shields your online banking from malware and other malicious activities. Our new system looks and works a little different than you are currently used to and we believe you'll enjoy the changes. We are very excited about our enhanced security offerings along with its business-oriented functionality.

There are several things we are asking you to look into prior to the date our systems go live with our enhanced system so that your banking activities continue to run as anticipated. There will be a dedicated team on the bank's incoming phone lines to assist you with questions/concerns.

SYSTEM OUTAGE AND NEW SYSTEM INSTALL:

System Outage	Yes	Our Online Banking system will be down from 7:00 pm on 2/5/21 until 2/8/21. You will NOT be able to log into Online Banking until 2/8/21. Please ensure you have handled all of your online banking activity prior to 7:00 pm on 2/5/21
Secure Browser Download and System Training	Yes	A bank representative will be in contact with you prior to 2/8/21 to assist in the install of the secure browser and assist with any questions you may have. Please ensure administrative rights and/or tech assistance available on the device you will download the secure browser on.
NEW Online Banking Link: Treasury Cash Management	Yes	This new link will be available to you on 2/8/21 https://wtnbtreasurycashmanagement.com
Web Browser	Yes	Windows 7 is NOT supported.
System Requirements	Yes	Attached to this letter
Log In and Password	Yes	ID will remain the same but you will be provided additional credentials through secured email. Please ENSURE WTNB has your current email address.
User Agreement and	Yes	Revised documents will be sent to you via DocuSign (electronic signature)

Bill Pay – System Outage	Yes	Bill Pay will be down from 2/4/21 until 2/8/21.
Bill Pay – Scheduled Payments prior to 2/4	Yes	Please NOTE any automatically scheduled payments already set up in Bill Pay prior to 2/4/21 will still go as scheduled.
Bill Pay – Recurring Payments:	Yes	Recurring Bill Payments: There will be some history with recurring payments that will systematically move over, but you must review on or after 2/8 to ensure all of your recurring payments are accurate or may need to be rebuilt.

ACH and Wire users - 1	Yes	Ensure you have backed up all of your future and reoccurring payments and reports by close of business on 2/5/21.
ACH and Wire users – 2	Yes	Recurring payments will <u>NOT</u> transfer over and will require you to rebuild your recurring payment list on or after 2/8/21.

Automatic Transfers	Yes	If you currently have any automatic transfers set up in Online Banking, between any of your accounts we recommend you prepare a list of these. Although we expect all of this detail to systematically transition to the new system, this will help you be prepared in the event any of your transfers are missing. If something does not look right on 2/8/21 , we are available to assist you if needed during your validation.

Check Images and eStatements	No	Will still be available in the new system

NOTES and Helpful Hints:

- Starting January 14th, 2020 Windows 7 was no longer supported
- Commercial Users: Securebrowser is **NOT** supported on Chromebooks. **We can provide you other access points if you currently use a ChromeBook**
- Admin. Rights are required to download Securebrowser
- If you have any issues accessing Treasury Management Cash Management System, WTNB is available to assist you.

Browsers

- Internet Explorer (Version 11) – **Note: we see intermittent issues with Internet Explorer**
- Microsoft Edge (Any version currently supported by Microsoft)
- Mozilla Firefox (Version 65+)
- Google Chrome (Version 70+)
- Apple Safari browser is **NOT** officially supported but there are no known issues between most recent version of Safari and CBS software
- Commercial Center Secure Browser (CCS)
 - Computers must have a Personal System/2 (PS/2) style or USB Human Interface Device (HID) keyboard installed
 - The following platforms do **NOT** support CCS:
 - Windows Server
 - Windows Phone or Windows 10 Mobile
 - Windows 10 S (preinstalled on 2017 Surface Laptop and Surface Pro hardware)
 - This application is **NOT** compatible with anti-virus products that utilize Device Control software
 - Application does **NOT** support installing in Remote Desktop Services (RDS, formerly Terminal Services) and multi-user thin-client virtual desktop infrastructure (VDI) environments due to common issues with keyboard encryption, snapshot management and folder redirection, depending on how you configured the environment

Windows OS

NOTE: 32- and 64-bit operating systems supported

- **Windows 8, 8.1, and 10 (Secure Browser or Desktop)**
 - Dual core 2 GHz or more microprocessor
 - 2GB of RAM (32bit) or 4GB of RAM (64bit)

Mac OS

 - iPads and iPhones running iOS 11 or newer
 - Note: Only the most recent release of an OS version is supported. For example, if iOS 100.4.9 is publicly available, then release 100.4.8 is no longer supported. However, the most recent release of iOS 99 would still be supported.
- **Android**
 - Phones and tablets running OS 5 or newer
 - 1.2 GHZ dual core chip or better
 - 1 GB or more of RAM

Intuit product users are encouraged to download a QFX/QBO file during this outage.

The following services will **NOT** work during the outage:

- Quicken Win/Mac Express Web Connect
- QuickBooks Online (QBO)
- Mint - Please **DO NOT open** Mint for **3-5 business days** after the **2/8/21** system migration to WTNB Treasury Cash Management to ensure the Mint product is properly updated.

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OFX Post-Conversion Troubleshooting Guide

Top 3 Post-Conversion Troubleshooting Issues

This resource document is designed to help Financial Institutions troubleshoot the three most common post-conversion issues. These materials include instructions for both QuickBooks and Quicken. All links are clickable in the PDF.

Issue 1: Duplicate Transactions After Reconnecting

Symptoms You Can Use to Identify the Issue

The most common report from customers is about duplicate transactions. Some customers may say their register is out of balance or that they are being asked to add an adjustment during reconciliation.

Fix the Issue

1. If the duplicate transactions have not been added to the register, they can be deleted individually prior to accepting.
2. If the transactions have already been added to the register, they can be deleted from the register individually or in groups.

Quicken Details

If there are too many transactions to delete individually, or the customer finds it difficult to follow the instructions to delete multiple transactions, restore a backup file and download the transactions again.

Important: If the backup was not made right before following the conversion instructions, the customer must manually delete the transactions.

Issue 2: Duplicate Accounts After Reconnecting

Symptoms You Can Use to Identify the Issue

Customers report that they are unable to link to an existing account, that they are prompted to create a new account, or that they are only given the choice to add a new account.

Fix the Issue

1. First, confirm that all accounts have been deactivated, including inactive (QuickBooks) or hidden (Quicken) accounts.
2. Then, if you're working in QuickBooks, delete any downloaded transactions that do not match the register in the Online Banking Center. If you're working in Quicken, delete the duplicate accounts.
3. Finally, repeat the reconnection steps.

Issue 3: Connected/Reconnected the Incorrect Account

Symptoms You Can Use to Identify the Issue

Customers report that their transactions are downloading into the wrong account.

Fix the Issue

1. First, open the account register for the incorrectly linked account.
2. If the transactions have not yet been accepted into the register in QuickBooks, delete them in the Online Banking Center. Then, deactivate the account. If the transactions have not yet been accepted into the register in Quicken, delete the transactions.
3. If the transactions have already been added to the register in Quicken or QuickBooks, restore a backup.
4. Finally, repeat the reconnection steps. Be sure the customer links to the correct account when reconnecting.
